This program is a collaboration between the **Korea Academy for Educators (KAFE)** and **USC Korean Studies Institute (USC KSI)** sponsored by the Korea Foundation. Selection for the seminar will be based on our assessment of applicants who are passionate about learning not only about Korean history and culture, but how ready and likely applicants are to create lessons to share with their schools.

Fellowships will include travel expenses, hotel stay for six nights, light breakfast and lunch. Applicants will receive notice of acceptance by April 15th.

In addition to the completed application form, please include the following:

1. A current resume (curriculum vita)
2. A letter of recommendation from your principal, assistant principal, or assistant head of school
3. As part of the application process, you will be asked to participate in an interview through Skype or phone call
4. A registration fee of \$350 payable to Korea Academy for Educators upon acceptance into the fellowship program. Upon completion of seminar and required assignments, you will receive \$150 in lesson plan support. (**Once your plane ticket is purchased, we will not be able refund your registration fee and you will be charged for the difference in airline ticket*)
